I have seen more coyotes this spring than ever. The prime time for calling is October – December. They have good prime fur and it's not too cold to spend a little time calling.

If any of you have heard rumors the Corrections Institution has closed their pheasant farm, it is true. We will be getting our birds from other sources. For all of you that hunt release sites, call WSWF to find out new information on their programs for this year.
